There are quite a few of us, so we thought we'd like to meet up, and maybe get involved in a spot of local feminist activism! So we are organising an initial get-together:

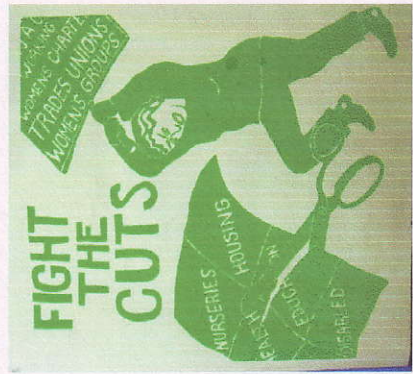
