Information for Applicants

Sometimes you get an idea that would make your workplace greener but you're not sure what to do with your idea, or whether it's possible, do-able or acceptable.

The Office of Environmental Sustainability (tOES) has developed a fund to support your ideas for Local Environmental Sustainability Action at Monash University. Whether your idea is to green up your event, improve energy-efficiency in your workplace equipment or lighting, improve waste management or raise awareness of environmental sustainability amongst other staff or students etc then we may be able to help you. Support might mean more people, time, space, equipment, permission or money.

The aim of the Fund is to help you make your ideas happen.

The Local Environmental Sustainability Action Fund can provide small grants for locally managed projects that will raise awareness or change practice in relation to environmental sustainability.



What do I do?

Apply to tOES for small grants to support your project or idea. Use the attached [application form](#). Your idea must relate to environmental sustainability by:

- increasing awareness
- changing work practices
- improving resource efficiency

Projects demonstrating the following characteristics will have an advantage:

- involving "hard to reach" groups people not already engaged with Sustainability
- involving both students and staff
- showing long-term sustainability rather than one-off events

What happens then?

Applications will be considered by tOES. We might need to ask you a few more questions when we have read your application, but we aim to reach a decision quickly. Then it's over to you!

We will ask you to provide us with a short report on your project once complete and we ask you to acknowledge tOES and Greening up our act in any publicity.
