HEALING

MANU descends from a lineage of well-known healers from Peru. He grew up in India, but developed his knowledge of the healing properties of Rainforest plants during his years of study with powerful native healers of Peru.

Manu is also a talented musician and has been taught to use the sacred vibration and powers of the didgeridoo to heal people on a soul-level. During the healing sessions Manu creates a soul-connection with the individual in order to gather information about the healing which is needed. He then uses the power of the didgeridoo to create vibrational shifts within the energy field.

Rainforest remedies may also be recommended as a way of providing additional support for the ongoing healing process.

CEREMONIES

Pagos A La Tierra (Payment to the Earth)

This ceremony comes from the Indigenous people of the Andes. It is an offering of grains, incense, fragrances, sweets, fruits, prayers and the hopes you wish to give to, and receive from, the Earth.

We make a bundle out of our offerings after having sat in circle and held a space of prayer and ritual. At this point the bundle is either buried together as a group, or the hosts of the ceremony place it in the earth at their home, or where the spirit indicates it should be placed.

This ceremony creates a vortex of energy that can heal the injured earth around the epicenter of the placement of the Pago. These actions also represent the conception/birth process. The Mother Earth is made fertile by our prayer and intent, and we impregnate her with our bundles of prayers and offerings. We receive her blessings as she gives birth in the form of a healthy and renewed planet.

This ceremony was taught to Manu by his father who learned it from the elders of the mountains. As time moves on Manu feels called more and more to perform this ritual payment to our Mother Earth. He realized that we take and receive much from her and we must give back. We must recognize what she means to us and how vital she is to our survival.

EDUCATION

Manu has spent his life as a seeker on the path to God. Born into an international family in Rio de Janeiro, he started traveling when he was two weeks old. He spent most of his childhood between India, Peru, and California; all the while learning about the spiritual aspects of life and the importance of walking one's own path. He has spent many years studying sacred medicine with the Shamans of the Amazon jungle and learning to sing their songs.

Manu has dedicated his life to bringing the healing energy of the jungle to the west, traveling the world and sharing what has been taught to him in order to better help his fellow man walk through this life with grace.

He has recently created a non-profit organization called <u>The Jungle Alliance of Medicine and Music</u> (JAMM). The purpose of JAMM is to help to save the rapidly decreasing Amazon Rainforest by teaching and educating the people about its magic. It is Manu's hope that this organization will bring medicine to both the people of the west, as well as educate the native people of the land on how to use their natural resources without destroying them.

CHILDREN

Manu travels to schools to speak with the children to tell them the stories of the Rain Forest. By sharing his experiences with the Elements and Mysteries of the Plants and Trees he hopes to inspire the students the to carry the torch of conservation forward. Manu shares the belief that the children of today are our future. They are the future stewards of our Earth and what we plant within them now will bear fruit in later on.

MUSIC

MANU has a particular passion for bringing knowledge of the healing powers of the Rainforest plants to the West. He is working to capture the healing songs and ceremonies of the native people as they work with, and harvest, the plants. His first album of didgeridoo music was released last year, and he is currently working on another project of healing music.
