

# CEMIL MUST STAY



My name is Cemil Dogan, I am 28 years old and I have lived in Britain for three years. I came here as a political refugee. In Turkey I was arrested 9 times between 1996-2000. I suffered torture which included electric shocks, suspension from the ground by my hands and torture by high pressure water hose.

I have been refused refugee status twice now. In August 2004 a tribunal appeal agreed that my case required a review. Following a 2nd home office interview I was once again refused on the grounds that Turkey is safe.

In June 2005, 17 members of my organisation -the Maoist Communist Party (MKP) of Turkey & North Kurdistan, formerly called Turkish Communist Party- Marx Leninist, were assassinated at the organisation's 2nd congress. They were killed by a wing of the Turkish army.

I fear that if I were to return to Turkey I would face torture and solitary confinement. Please support my right to refugee status.
